

Vacancy: Financial expert - member of MCNV's Supervisory Board

MCNV is looking for a member, serving as financial expert of the Supervisory Board, The task of the Supervisory Board is to ensure that the efforts of the MCNV make an optimal contribution towards the mission of MCNV:

"To contribute to the structural improvement of the health of disadvantaged groups in South-east Asia by developing evidence-based participatory models that build capacity and focus on the major determinants of population health."

The Supervisory Board also has an advisory role.

The primary responsibility of the Supervisory Board is to exercise supervision as stated in the Statute, Code of Governance, specifically:

- Accountability in advance (policy-making, annual workplans and budget)
- Supervising the performance of the Board of Director and hence the organisation
- Accountability in retrospect (adoption/approval of Board of Director's decisions).

We are seeking a **financial expert in the Supervisory Board**, with expertise and experience in one or more of the following fields:

1. Holds a qualification in business economics or business administration and possesses extensive knowledge and experience in the field of finance.
2. Possesses comprehensive financial-economic insight, enabling a clear understanding of the financial implications of strategic policy and external developments, as well as the associated accountability and reporting requirements.
3. Understands issues regarding financial continuity, treasury, and financing, and can interpret financial figures, look beyond the numbers, and identify risks in a timely manner.
4. Preferably resides in the Netherlands.
5. The Finance expert serves as the Chair of the Supervisory Board's Audit Committee.

In addition, as a supervisory board member, we seek the candidate who possesses one or more of the following fields:

1. Governance in (non) profit sector, public health issues, technical network in rehabilitation for people with disabilities, institutional fundraising, knowledge of legal and governance issues in Vietnam and/or other Southeast Asian countries.
2. Experience in development cooperation, in particular for Vietnam/ Laos or other Southeast Asia countries;
3. Good command of English especially related to development cooperation;
4. Absence of conflicts of interest;
5. Irreproachable conduct;
6. No history of employment by the MCNV and no close relationships with the Board;
7. Willingness to make the necessary effort to perform effectively;
8. Willingness to participate in meetings (4-6 half-days a year, generally in the evening);

Members of the Supervisory Board do not receive remuneration. They will receive compensation for expenses made while working as MCNV's Supervisory Board member. When the membership of the Supervisory Board requires presence in Vietnam and/or Laos the travel and hotel costs will be compensated.
